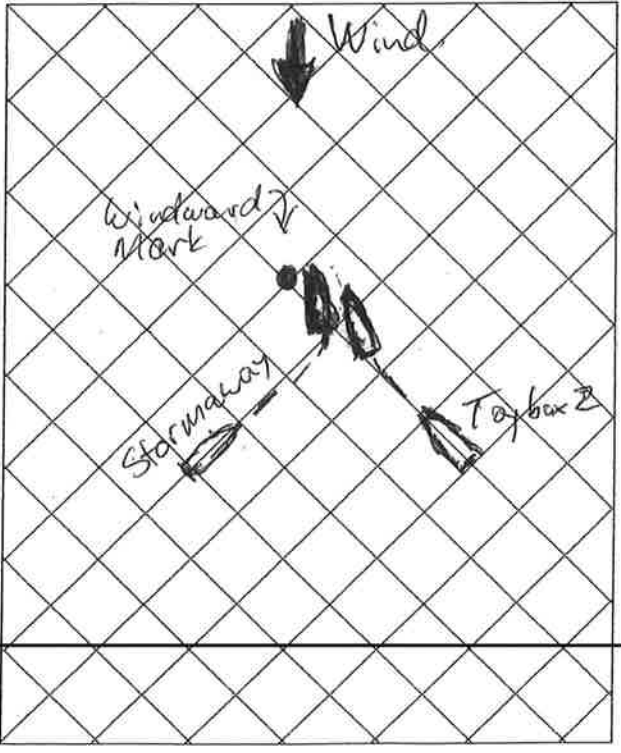

Toybox 2 approached windward mark on starboard layline. Toybox 2 hailed starboard on Stormaway who was approaching on port. Stormaway tacked onto starboard within 1 boat length of the mark causing Toybox 2 to have to steer above close-hauled to starboard to have to avoid colliding with Stormaway. However, Stormaway did not complete his tack onto starboard - he only pointed his boat into the wind and relied on his momentum to get him around the mark.
