Protest No. 4 and Request for Redress No 5

Race 4

MH53 Gogo v MH 101 Rock Solid

Hearing at Middle Harbour Yacht Club, on 24 February 2016 at 19:00 Hours.

Gogo was represented by: Matthew Watt

Rock Solid was represented by: Mitchell Miller

FACTS FOUND

- Race 4 was sailed in wind S 15kt.
- 2. Gogo and Rock Solid were sailing downwind on starboard tack.
- 3. Gogo became overlapped within two of her hull lengths to leeward of Rock Solid.
- 4. Gogo was sailing a higher course than Rock Solid to reach an area of better wind.
- 5. Rock Solid did not change course.
- 6. There was contact when the main sheet of *Rock Solid* fouled a winch of *Gogo*, dislodging the winch from the deck.
- 7. Gogo retired.
- 8. Neither boat took penalty turns.

CONCLUSION AND RULES THAT APPLY

- A. Gogo did not sail above her proper course. Gogo did not break rule 17.
- B. Rock Solid, to windward on the same tack, did not keep clear of Gogo. Rock Solid broke rule 11.
- C. It was not reasonably possible for *Gogo* to avoid contact. *Gogo* did not break rule 14.
- D. Rock Solid did not avoid contact with Gogo when it was reasonably possible to do so. Rock Solid broke rule 14.

DECISION

Rock Solid is disqualified from Race 4.

CONSIDERATION OF REDRESS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. Rock Solid requested redress for giving help to Gogo in accordance with rule 62.1(c).
- 2. The protest committee considered redress for *Gogo* in accordance with rule 60.3(b).
- 3. Estimated time to repair Gogo was one week.
- 4. There will be no further races in the series for at least two weeks.

CONCLUSION AND RULES THAT APPLY

- A. The score of *Rock Solid*, having been disqualified, was not made worse by *Rock Solid* giving help. *Rock Solid* is not entitled to redress in accordance with rule 62.1.
- B. The score of *Gogo* was made significantly worse by physical damage caused by *Rock Solid* breaking rules 11 and 14. *Gogo* is entitled to Redress in accordance with rule 62.1(b).

DECISION

Redress is not given to Rock Solid.

Gogo is to be scored points equal to the average, to the nearest tenth of a point (0.05 to be rounded upward), of her points in all the races before race 4
