CHANGES TO INSHORE SPRINT SAILING INSTRUCTIONS FOR SATURDAY 6 OCTOBER 2018

The Sydney Amateur Sailing Club Super 30 fleet will join the MHYC Sprint races on Saturday October 6, 2018. For this date only, the Sprint Sailing Instructions in the MHYC 2018-2019 Sailing Handbook are amended as follows.
