MHYC E-Sailing Series will be conducted on the Virtual Regatta (VR) online platform

The Organising Authority (OA) is Middle Harbour Yacht Club

# **UPDATED 24 APRIL 2020**

### 1. RULES

- 1.1 The racing will be governed by the Virtual Racing Rules of Sailing which can be found <a href="https://example.com/here.">here.</a>
- 1.2 There will be no protests for incidents while racing, any penalties will be applied by VR.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 2.1 The Series are open to members of the MHYC (all categories).
- 2.2 There may be a minimum of six (6) and up to nineteen (19) entrants in each division.
- 2.3 Divisions will be allocated by the OA once entries have been received.
- 2.4 Enter by emailing the following information to <a href="mailto:sailing@mhyc.com.au">sailing@mhyc.com.au</a> no later than 5pm on the day before the series commences:
  - E-Sailing Series (Wednesday, Thursday or Saturday)
  - Skipper Name
  - Pseudo
  - Mobile number
- 2.5 Late series entries may be accepted at the discretion of the OA.
- 2.6 Casual entries may be accepted no later than 2 hours before the scheduled race session.

### 3. FEES

3.1 There is no entry fee.

### 4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 4.1 Scheduled dates and times for racing are:
  - Saturdays at 1pm Apr 25, May 2, 9, 16, 23, 30, Jun 6, 13 (8 sessions)
  - Wednesdays at 1pm Apr 29, May 6, 13, 20, 27, Jun 3, 10, 17 (8 sessions)
  - Thursdays at 6pm Apr 30, May 7, 14, 21, 28, Jun 4, 11, 18 (8 sessions)
- 4.2 The scheduled time for the first race to be set up is 2 minutes before race time.
- 4.3 Five back to back races will be conducted in each session.
- 4.4 The OA reserves the right to amend the schedule at any time.

## 5. COURSES AND CLASSES

- 5.1 Courses will be windward-leeward, two laps.
- 5.2 Classes will be as follows:
  - Wednesday Series J70 Day Racer (Spinnaker)
  - Thursday Series Star (Non-Spinnaker)
  - Saturday Series Offshore Racer (Spinnaker)

# 6. DROP OUTS / CONNECTION ISSUES

6.1 There shall be no redress for dropping out or failing to connect to a race for any reason.

### 7. SCORING

- 7.1 Wednesday, Thursday and Saturday races shall be scored as separate series.
- 7.2 Results will be calculated on One-Design (OD) and Performance Handicap (PHS).
- 7.3 Scoring shall be as per RRS Appendix A, Low Point System.
- 7.4 Five races are required to constitute a series.
- 7.5 A boat's worst score will be excluded after every five (5) races to a maximum of eight (8) excluded scores.

### 8. COMMUNICATION

- 8.1 Entrants will receive an email no later than 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start time with the joining codes for the races.
- 8.2 Alerts may be sent by SMS.

### 9. PRIZES

- 9.1 Series prizes will be awarded as follows:
  - One Design 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>
  - Performance Handicap 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>

- Create an account The pseudo you choose appears as your boat name on race day

- Enter the code provided for the race emailed before the first race on each race day
