NOTICE OF RACE

The notation of '[DP]' in a rule in the NoR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The 2017-2020 Special Regulations of Australian Sailing (AS) for Category 7 shall apply.

2 ADVERTISING

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The Daydream Shield will be contested by Club Teams from SASC and MHYC.
- 3.2 Late changes to entries may be accepted at the discretion of the OA.
- 3.3 To identify Team Boats while racing, SASC and MHYC boats will fly their Club Burgee [DP].

4 CLASSIFICATION

5 FEES

- 5.1 There is no Regatta Entry Fee

6 DIVISIONS

The Daydream Shield will be contested in conjunction with Division 2 and Division 3 Sprint Races on November 7. Boats will be allocated to Divisions by the Organising Authority.

7 SCHEDULE – 7 November 2020

- 7.1 First Warning Signal 1255hrs
- 7.2 Two (2) races are scheduled. The warning signal for the subsequent race will be made as soon as practicable after the preceding race.

8 PROVIDED BOATS

Not used.

9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available by 1700hrs on Thursday 5 November, 2020 on the MHYC website and via email to SASC entrants.

10 VENUE

10.1 Attachment A shows the proposed location of the racing areas.

11 THE COURSES

11.1 The courses to be sailed will be windward-leeward as described in the Sailing Instructions.

12 PENALTY SYSTEM

Not used.

13 SCORING

13.1 Two (2) races are scheduled and one (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

13.2 No scores will be excluded.

13.3 A Fixed Event Handicap (EHC) will be allocated to each boat by the Organising Authority.

13.4 Scoring System: The race scores of the two best placed boats from each club in each division in each race shall be used. The Club with the lowest combined points wins the Daydream Shield.

14 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall display the Club Burgee of the team they are supporting [DP].

15 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. [DP]

16 PRIZES

The Daydream Shield Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the team with the lowest aggregate score.

17 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

18 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million per incident or the equivalent.
