NOTICE OF RACE

Revised 2 February 2022

The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the NoR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Appendix UF Adams 10 Australian Championships 2022 Edition (Umpired Fleet Races) will apply.

2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority (OA). If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. [DP]

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The Regatta is open to boats of the Adams 10 Metre Class that meet the following requirements:

a) Each Entrant and Crew shall be a financial member of a Club affiliated with their World Sailing Member National Authority. Attention of entrants is drawn to RRS 75.

b) Each Entrant shall be a financial member of the Adams 10 Metre Class Association. The membership fee per boat is \$150.

c) Each crew member shall be a financial member of the Adams 10 Metre Class Association. Cost is \$20 per crew member.

d) Association membership and crew fees are to be deposited to the Association's bank account prior to 4 February 2022 at CBA Neutral Bay Branch BSB 06 2210 and Account 10201892.

e) Each skipper or owner will forward a crew list and association membership to the Association by 4 February 2022 via email <u>kimberdarling@gmail.com.</u>

f) Each yacht shall hold a current and valid Adams 10 Metre Class Weight Certificate.
g) Yachts that do not have a Weight Certificate can apply to be weighed by the Association on Friday 4th at RANSA.

h) Owners or PIC will be required to sign a Declaration of Class Compliance.

i) Each yacht shall provide evidence of valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.

j) Each yacht shall provide a valid Category 7 Certificate.

- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter online at <u>www.mhyc.com.au</u> by 1000 hours on Friday 28 January 2022.
- 3.3 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the OA.

4 FEES

4.1 The Regatta Entry Fee is AUD \$495.00 (including gst) payable online to MHYC.

- 5.2 A maximum of 7races may be sailed.
- 5.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 1155hrs on Saturday and 1055hrs on Sunday.
- 5.4 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 1500hrs.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available by 1700hrs on Thursday 3 February at <u>www.mhyc.com.au</u>.

7 VENUE

Attachment A shows the location of the regatta harbour and the racing areas.

8 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be windward-leeward as described in the Sailing Instructions.

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

Penalties are amended by Appendix UF Adams 10 Australian Championships 2022 Edition.

10 SCORING

- 10.1 RRS Appendix A2, will apply.
- 10.2 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 10.3 When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 10.4 When 6 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the marina. [DP]

12 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Keelboats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee. [DP]

13 DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

Underwater breathing apparatus shall not be used around keelboats and boat bags shall remain open between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta. [DP]

14 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. [DP]

15 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

- a) One Design First Place (perpetual trophy)
- b) One Design Second & Third Places
- c) PHS Handicap First Place
- d) Wooden Seat First Place (perpetual trophy)
- e) Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority

20 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

21 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 Million per incident or the equivalent.

22 BOAT MEASUREMENT

- 22.1 Each boat must have a weight certificate that specifies overall weight.
- 22.2 Such certificate can be issued by any Association executive member.
- 22.3 The Association has organised for measurement to take place on Friday 4 February 2022 at RANSA starting at 0700hrs. Each boat skipper/owner must book a time with Kim Darling at <u>kimberdarling@gmail.com</u>
- 22.4 The entry fee includes the cost of weighing each boat.
