NOTICE OF RACE

The notation of '[DP]' in a rule in the NoR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The 2021-2024 Special Regulations of Australian Sailing (AS) for Category 7 shall apply.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The Daydream Shield will be sailed by Club Teams. One team from SASC and one from MHYC will sail in yachts of identical classes, with one of each class sailed by each team.
- 3.2 Late changes to entries may be accepted at the discretion of the OA.
- 3.3 All crew members shall be current financial members of SASC or MHYC.
- 3.4 To identify Team Boats while racing, SASC and MHYC boats will fly their Club Burgee.

- 5.1 There is no Regatta Entry Fee

6 QUALIFYING SERIES AND FINAL SERIES

7 SCHEDULE – 14 November 2021

7.1 First Warning Signal 1255hrs

7.2 Three (3) races are scheduled. The warning signal for each subsequent race will be made as soon as practicable after the preceding race.

7.3 No warning signal will be made after 1600hrs.

8 PROVIDED BOATS

Not used.

9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available by 1700hrs on Thursday 11 November 2021 on the SASC and MHYC websites.

10 VENUE

10.1 Attachment A shows the location of the regatta harbour and the racing areas.

11 THE COURSES

11.1 The courses to be sailed will be windward-leeward as described in the Sailing Instructions.

12 PENALTY SYSTEM

Not used.

13 SCORING

13.1 One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

13.2 Scoring System: RRS Appendix A except that each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores.

13.3 The Club with the lowest combined team series score wins the Daydream Shield.

14 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall display the Club Burgee of the team they are supporting [DP].

15 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. [DP]

16 PRIZES

The Daydream Shield Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the team with the lowest aggregate score.

17 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

18 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million per incident or the equivalent.
