## **CONFLICT OF INTEREST**

Protest Committee members declared that they had no conflicts of interest and no party objected to the members hearing the protest.

# FACTS FOUND

- 1. Race 1 was sailed offshore in wind ENE 10 to 15 kts and low seas.
- 2. Shine On was sailing on starboard tack on a beat to windward.
- 3. Stormaway was sailing on port tack on a beat to windward.
- 4. Boats were on converging courses.
- 5. Shine On hailed 'starboard' and Stormaway tacked.
- 6. Stormaway reached a close hauled course clear ahead and less than 5m from Shine On
- 7. Shine On, sailing faster changed course to windward and kept clear of Stormaway.

## CONCLUSION AND RULES THAT APPLY

- A. Stormaway, a boat acquiring right of way, initially gave Shine On room to keep clear in accordance with rule 15.
- B. Shine On, clear astern, kept clear of Stormaway as required by rule 12.

### DECISION

No boat broke a rule.

The protest is dismissed.
