MHYC Thursday Pre-Christmas Twilight Series 2024

Shibumi v Renaissance Division 2

Hearing at MHYC, on 6 November 2024 at 17:00.

Shibumi was represented by: Bryan Moore

Renaissance was not represented. Mike Lowry is the nominated representative.

Conflict of interest

Protest Committee members declared that they had no conflicts of interest and no party objected to the members hearing the protest.

Validity

- 1. Shibumi delivered a Hearing Request containing the information required by rule 61.2 to the race office within the protest time limit [2130].
- 2. Shibumi hailed 'protest' and displayed red flag at the first reasonable opportunity.
- 3. The protest is valid. The Person-in-charge, Mike Lowry, was contacted and indicated he would not be attending. The hearing proceeded in accordance with RRS 63.3 (b).

FACTS FOUND

- 1. The race was sailed in wind SE 15 kts reducing to around 10knots at the time of the incident. Boats sailed a Course 4.
- 2. Renaissance crossed the Finish Line while it was racing and whilst the Finish Line displayed a blue flag. Note Renaissance, a division 2 boat, followed boats in division 3 that were finishing correctly.
- 3. Both boats continued to race and finished.
- 4. Both Shibumi and Renaissance were series entrants in the Pre Christmas Point-score.
- 5. Renaissance was scored 5 out of 9 entrants in Race 4. Shibumi was scored 6.

CONCLUSION AND RULES THAT APPLY

- A. Renaissance broke MHYC Season 2024-2025 NOR clauses 2.3 and 19.2.
- B. Competitors are also drawn to this requirement of NOR 2.3 in the prelude to the Sailing Instructions: "A boat shall not sail or motor through a MHYC finish line unless it is finishing. The on-water finish line is activated when the Blue Flag is displayed on the Race Committee Vessel."
- C. SI 9.2 of the Twilight Season SI states: "For an infringement of any other rule or requirement" [other than an infringement of RRS part 2] "the scoring Penalties of RRS 44.3 shall apply". Rule 44.3 imposes a 20% scoring penalty unless otherwise stated in the relevant SI.

DECISION

Renaissance broke NOR 2.3 and 19.2. Renaissance is given a 2 point scoring penalty and is scored 7 in Race 4.

The scores of all other boats are not changed.
